Our English Christian Heritage Tour 2012

Day 1: Tuesday - Depart USA

Depart on your international overnight flight.

Day 2: Wednesday - Arrive in England - Cambridge

Our representatives will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your coach to begin your England tour. Touring on our deluxe coach through the beautiful rolling hills of the central English countryside, we stop in the university city of Cambridge, and tour King's College Chapel, one of England's architectural gems. The Chapel houses Rubens's *The Adoration of the Magi*. Cambridge has been a celebrated University town since 1209 when a small group of students, who were fleeing from riot-torn Oxford, established a seat of learning there. At the "White Horse" tavern, a group of men introduced concepts from the German Reformation to England. Continue to your Midlands area hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Thursday - Elstow, Olney, & Oxford

This morning we journey to Elstow to see the church of John Bunyan's early childhood. Enjoy a tour of Bedford, home of John Bunyan and visit the Bunyan Museum here. We'll continue to Olney to see John Newton's grave before going to Oxford to tour Christ Church College, one of the 39 colleges that are a part of Oxford University. We will visit the beautiful Christ Church Cathedral which houses beautiful paintings and is home to Great Tom, an 18,000 pound bell, which rings every night at 9:05 signaling the closing of the college gates. Return to your Midlands hotel for dinner and overnight.



Day 4: Friday - Windsor & London

Visit the martyr's site before continuing on to Windsor to visit the traditional home of the British Monarchy, Windsor Castle. Here you will explore the state apartments (if open), which house a fabulous collection of treasures including works of art by Van Dyck, Rubens, and Rembrandt. We also visit St. George's Chapel, the burial place of the last ten Sovereigns of the British Empire. Free time to explore the picturesque streets of Windsor is given before busing by nearby Runnymede, the site of the signing of the Magna Carta. Our local guide will take us on a panoramic sightseeing tour of London before stopping in near Westminster Abbey. This famous church was where the Westminster Confession of Faith was written and is the location of many of the graves of many of the world's most famous people including many of the early Kings and Queens of England. You will have time to walk around this area of London. Those wanting to go into Westminster may do so (cost extra). End the day at our London hotel where we will spend the first of two nights in one of the world's most beautiful cities.

Day 5: Saturday - London

We continue our time in London with a short stop at Buckingham Palace, and then heading to Bunhill Fields Cemetery, known as the “cemetery of Puritan England.” Walking through the cemetery, you will see the graves of John Bunyan—Pilgrim’s Progress, Issac Watts--noted hymn writer, Daniel Defoe—Robinson Crusoe, Susannah Wesley—mother of John and Charles Wesley, as well as members of the Cromwell family. Also the writer, John Milton, lived in Bunhill Row on the west side of the cemetery from 1662 until his death in 1674. Across the street, we visit the Wesley Church located at the Wesley House and Museum and the location of his gravesite. The Chapel has been the Mother Church of Methodism since the 18th century. We’ll continue by touring the magnificently-designed St. Paul’s Cathedral. See the Metropolitan Tabernacle, reconstructed on the site of Charles Spurgeon’s 6,000 seat facility. Here Spurgeon served for 31 years in the late 1800’s, and his ministry and sermons still impact preachers across denominational lines. Enjoy the rest of the day on your own to explore the city of London, her museums, parks and shops. Perhaps stop by St. Martin in the Fields Church, remembered for its work with the homeless of London. Dinner tonight is on your own, so that you are free to enjoy your choice of London cuisine.



Day 6: Sunday - Canterbury & Greenwich

This morning, we will check out of our London hotel and bus to Canterbury, the ecclesiastical capital of England. We tour the historic Canterbury Cathedral where Thomas a Becket, the Archbishop of Canterbury, was murdered by four knights of Henry II in 1170. We’ll journey to Greenwich Observatory, where the National Maritime Museum is housed in buildings forming another symmetrical group and grand arcade around the Queen's House, designed by Inigo Jones. The park rises towards Blackheath. Nearby, a major group of buildings within the park is the former Royal Observatory, Greenwich. The Prime Meridian passes through this building. Greenwich Mean Time was at one time based on the time observations made at the Royal Greenwich Observatory, before being superseded by Coordinated Universal Time. Return to the London airport area for dinner and overnight.



Day 7: Monday - Return to USA

After a nourishing breakfast, we check out of our hotel and go to our **London airport** for our flight back home.

Final payment for trip, including optional travel protection premium if applicable, is due 60 days prior to departure. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed. After final payment date, new registrants may incur significantly higher fees.

SAVINGS: Save an additional \$20 when you register online. Early registration discounts are not available to Hosts/Co-Hosts and are deducted from the balance of your bill.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While EOT will try to match roommates, EOT cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$398 during the basic tour, \$248 for London on own extension.

AIRLINE ROUTES and TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, EOT does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once "printed", airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. EOT is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making own flight arrangements to departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties.

ITINERARY CHANGES: Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure. While you will see all sites listed above, the order of sites and/or days and number of days may be altered to accommodate changes in airline, hotel schedules, and local conditions. Due to airline schedules, some participants may receive one or two extra leisure days at a nominal per day charge and some extensions may not be available on all departure dates. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$120 per night; single rooms \$160 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees.
