Join Jesus in the Grand Adventure of Changing Our World!

Jesus began His earthly ministry by preaching in the villages surrounding the Sea of Galilee. One morning Jesus was teaching on the shore of Galilee's Sea when he encountered Simon Peter. What is the Meaning of Eyes in the Bible?

It is often said that the eyes are the window to the soul. The same is certainly true in the Bible. Scripture is full of fascinating phrases where *ayin* (עין) the Hebrew word for "eye" is used to refer to something deeper. Let's delve into the eye of the Bible...

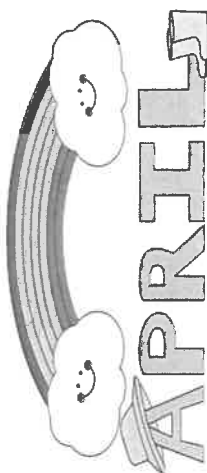
In many instances, the Hebrew word *ayin* עין meaning "eye" refers to the physical organ on our faces. But just as frequently, the word "eye" stands for a deeper feature of one's character. This is because in the world of ancient Israel the eyes were regarded as a sign of one's genuine character.

What is behind the eyes?

Let's see a few examples:

- The Bible warns against displaying an *ayin ra'ah* "evil eye" towards the needy – resentfully withholding assistance (Deut. 28:54).
- Behaving mercifully or having pity is having a "pitying eye" עין חס *has ayin* (Deut. 7:16)
- Eyes can be an indication of lofty arrogance – *room einav* עֵינָיו רוּם meaning "high looks" (Isa. 10:12).
- The opposite is "low eyes" *shah' einaim* שָׁח עֵינָיִם – It is the trait of the humble, whom God will save according to Job 22:29.

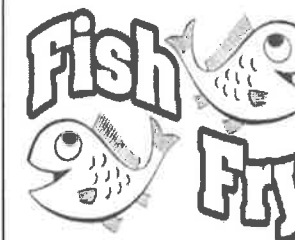

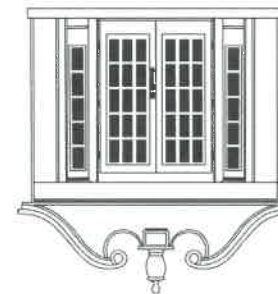
